# Math Options: Students Currently taking Math I

#### Math 2 Standard - Students must have passed Math 1 in 8th Grade:

• Best fit for students who struggled with the Math 1 curriculum.

• This course allows students who may have struggled in Math 1 the chance to move at a slower pace and review fundamental concepts from the Math 1 curriculum while learning the Math 2 curriculum.

#### Math 2 Honors:

- Best fit for students earning an A in Math 1 without corrections on tests.
- This course moves at a fast pace and students will have to be able to use problem solving skills to answer high level mathematics questions.
- Students are often required to integrate skills from previous courses and units when answering questions.
- Students in our Honors Math courses are required to complete written portfolios for every unit.



## Math Options: Students in Math 8

#### Math 1 One Semester -- Honors & Standard:

Honors -- Best fit for students earning an A in 8th grade Math without corrections

• This course moves at a fast pace and students will have to be able to use problem solving skills to answer high level mathematics questions.

Traditionally students in Math 1 One Semester take Math 2 Honors as sophomores.

#### Math 1 in Two Semesters: Foundations of Math I & Math I

- Most Freshmen will be placed into this course.
- Allows students to integrate into high school taking the mathematics at a slower pace and developing fundamental skills.

Math 1 Progression: Three Credits - Introduction to High School Math, Foundations of Math 1, & Math 1 fall semester Sophomore year

- Students in this pathway will take Intro to Mathematics in the Fall and Foundations of Math 1
  in the Spring.
- The goal is to allow this group of students a hand-on approach to mathematics while reviewing fundamental concepts.
